

How We Are To Live At A Time Like This: COVID-19

Zephaniah 3:8-20; Leviticus 26:9-13

Dear Members and Friends,

Last Sunday, the message focused on how we are to live in a time like this. The key points of the message were as follows:

We are to live by faith in our Lord Jesus Christ. God delivered His people from Egypt, delivered them from Babylonia after they worshipped the gods of Assyria, and WILL deliver us from COVID-19.

As Christians, we must not panic. As believers in Jesus Christ, we overcome by the, “blood of the Lamb and by the word of [our] testimony” (Revelation 12:11 NKJV). Furthermore, God LOVES US. Even though we sin, he allows us to confess and repent (I John 1:9)! He loves us SO MUCH that He “rejoices” over us (Zephaniah 3:17).

The world is looking at the Church right now. We are on center stage. People who profess no faith are looking at the Church to observe our speech and behavior. **What a great opportunity to share Christ (John 3:16)!**

I ended with a couple of scriptures: “For God has not given us a spirit of fear, **but of power and of love and of a sound mind**” (I Timothy 1:7 NKJV), “He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord – **“He is my refuge and my fortress; My God, in Him I will trust”**” (Psalm 91:1,2 NKJV).

God will guide us THROUGH this together. I am praying for our families, our church, our city, our country, and the world.
