“Stiff-Necked People - Part I” Numbers 21:4-9

A. Premise - The premise for this message was that we should consult the Holy Spirit regularly to see if there is any stiff-necked behavior we are displaying toward God.

B. Problem - Sometimes people would rather die than obey God.

C. Application - We should humble ourselves and obey what God says.

We might be stiff-necked if:

1. We haven't accepted Christ as our personal Savior.
2. We don't belong to a local church family even if the Holy Spirit has directed us to the one He knows is right for us.
3. We are in the WRONG church. The Holy Spirit either did not send us there or told us to move.
4. We are in the church He directed, but we are behaving in a stiff-necked manner toward His leadership in that place.
